

### **NB3d. Formalizing the reporting of JCNA members participating in Display Class for credit towards the Fred Horner Award.**

#### **Background**

In the past the Fred Horner Sportsman Award was presented for competition in Concours, Rally and Slalom events. The pre-requisites for the award have been revised to require only simple participation with a Jaguar vehicle in all JCNA sanctioned events, eliminating the need for actual competition.

#### **Problem**

Up to now, showing a car in Display has not been regarded as formal participation in the concours event. Members that only “displayed” their vehicles have not been consistently accounted for or reported to JCNA. That accounting and reporting process needs to be corrected.

#### **Proposed Action**

The JCRC has requested that the vehicle reporting forms and instructions be updated to clearly include Display as a formal concours category. Concours officials will be directed to record and report all Display Entrants so that, where appropriate, their participation will be credited towards the annual Fred Horner Sportsman Award.

##### **B. CONCOURS DIVISIONS**

###### **1. The Official Concours Divisions**

Each sanctioned JCNA Concours d’Elegance will provide for Entries in Champion Division, Driven Division, and Special Division Classes.

###### **2. Unofficial Divisions**

"Display-only" is not an official JCNA Concours Division. It is a classification given to those Jaguars voluntarily positioned for viewing as pre-planned part of the event. This type of participation is promoted to both add to the number and variety of Jaguars being shown and to encourage future Concours entries.

##### **B. CONCOURS DIVISIONS AND DISPLAY**

###### **1. Official Concours Divisions**

Each sanctioned JCNA Concours d’Elegance will provide for Entries in Champion Division, Driven Division and Special Division.

###### **2. Display**

"Display" is not an official JCNA concours division but is a classification given to those Jaguars voluntarily positioned for viewing as a pre-planned part of the event. This type of participation is promoted to both add to the number and variety of Jaguars being shown and to encourage future concours entries. **Display entries are not formally judged, scored or given any competition points. However, Display participation (along with other specific JCNA competition events) qualifies as credit towards the Fred Horner Sportsman Award. For record purposes, member Display Entrants must be included when reporting concours results on the JCNA Competition Results web page, with the annotation “Disp” in the Class field.**
