# "Alfuar" Rally Challenge

*a nice drive to the Florida Keys, Sunday, February 10th, 2008 • 10:00 A.M. , Miami - Islamorada - Redlands*

Winter is our driving season with plenty of sunshine, no rain and cooler weather so there is no excuse it leave our cars in the garage; and even if we drive them on our own, isn't it better to do it as a pack?

We will meet at 10:00am in West Miami, near Tropical Park just off the Palmetto Expressway/Bird Road for a 90 minute drive down to the Upper Keys and lunch at a waterfront restaurant. Originally, this event was just going to be a tour but, to make it more fun, we're going to make a rally out of it... Dont' you let the word "rally" intimidate you. It's easy and it's all about fun.

The first two stages will take us to a waterfront restaurant in the Upper Keys, around Tavernier/Key Largo. After lunch, a third stage will take us back towards Miami. We'll probably have the finish line near a bar in the Redlands (south Dade) where results will be announced.

There will be prizes to the top three teams. To make things interesting, since this is a joint Alfa / Jaguar club event there will also be a club prize, to be known as the Alfuar (or is it Jagfa?) Rally Challenge. Points will be added for Jaguars and Alfas and the losing club will pick up the bar tab... While top places will help, a good turnout will also be important since points will be added together... you can probably say that quantity can make up for quality...

**Driving Direction to the start / meeting point :**

From the turnpike, exit at Bird Road - SW 40th Street and go east. The Park entrance will be on the right hand side, just past SW 82nd avenue.

From Broward County on I-95 : at the Golden Glades, get on the Palmetto Expressway / 826 and go south. Exit at Bird Road - SW 40th Street and drive west. The entrance to Tropical Park will be on the left side.

Please get there by 10:15 for the briefing, first car will go out at 10:30

**- Rally 101 -**

This event will be run following JCNA rally rules for Monte Carlo rallies, it is the most simple and easy form of rally.

At the pre rally briefing, we will hand out maps which will be your official and only maps you are allowed to use. The maps and instructions will give you the location of the check points marking the end of each stage as well as the time you are given to reach the check point. Cars will leave at one minute intervals and find their own route to the next check point. No step-by-step instructions are given in this type of rally, letting the navigator enjoy the drive...

When approaching the check point, instructions will tell you the location of the stand down area. If you are early, you are allowed to stop and wait for the clock to run down before making your way to the checkpoint. Once you leave the stand down area, you are not allowed to stop, so time it carefully.

When you reach the CP, the CP worker will write your time across the line, pull over WITHOUT stopping in the way and have your navigator bring the timing slip to the CP worker who will write your time down. They will also write your time out which will be the next minute and your official start time for the next stage.

At the end of the rally, your times will be compared to the official time and your score will be one point per second off (early or late). You will have plenty of time to complete each stage by driving well within the speed limits. You must respect ALL driving rules including speed limits : "Ocifer, I'm in a rally" will not work.
