Your JCNA leadership and the delegates to the recent AGM enthusiastically supported asking Land Rover owners to join JCNA. Adding Land Rover to the Jaguar marque would increase our membership and diversify our club activities. Some clubs have already integrated Land Rover into their annual concours with excellent outcomes.

There are many Land Rover clubs, but there has yet to be a unifying entity (like

JCNA) for them. We're not asking Land Rover owners to forfeit any current memberships they may have. We're just inviting them to join JCNA and show their machines off alongside ours and participate in all our local club activities such as meetings, parties, trips, tours, and informative sessions.

The strategy for implementation would start with JCNA clubs that have amiable relationships with their local JLR dealerships, reaching out to Land Rover/Range Rover/Discoverer enthusiasts in their area. These folks would be encouraged to join our clubs. For now, in order to comply with our Bylaws, each new member must be an owner of a Jaguar, or interested in Jaguar automobiles. If the acceptance of this venture is strong, Bylaws may need to be updated.

As the base of Land Rover owners increases, JCNA will need to develop additional class structures in our competition programs to meet the needs of this new sector. Local clubs could try to develop activities targeting Land Rover vehicles that are also of interest to Jaguar members.

If the inclusion of Land Rover owners is of interest to your club, please contact Southeast Regional Director, Dr. Craig Kerins, craigkerins15@gmail.com, 706-726-0434. Dr. Kerins is heading up a committee to advise your board as to the direction we

need to go to make this venture appealing to Land Rover owners and mutually beneficial to all involved.

The cost to a Land Rover owner would be the same as a Jaguar owner. They would pay local club and JCNA membership costs. This fun and exciting undertaking will require a concerted grassroots effort by many people. Are you up to the challenge?

Susan and I drove up to Tulsa recently to nail down the Fall Fling hotel, eating establishments and museums. We were impressed and think that everyone else will be also. It is looking like a very nice Fling.

We will meet at the car pool parking lot close to Cracker Barrel at 122nd Street and I-35 at 9:45 am on Friday, October 13th and leave for the drive to Tulsa at 10:00. We should arrive just in time for lunch at Sisserou's. This place is a Caribbean

restaurant...something that we have not tried before to my knowledge.



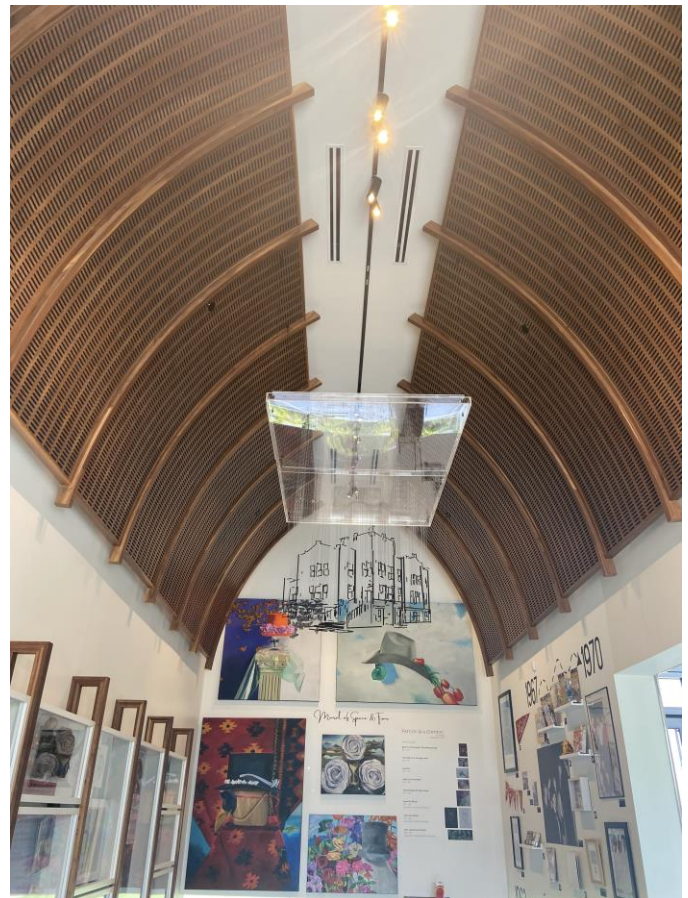

They have dishes from all over the Caribbean Islands and it's not all Jerk. They have something for everybody and was very good.

After lunch we will caravan off to the Church Studio. This is an old church that Oklahoma's own Leon Russell bought and turned into a recording studio. This has been the choice studio for the likes of Eric Clapton, Tom Petty, Willie Nelson, Stevie Wonder, Kansas and of course Leon himself. Parking will be on the street or in a nearby parking lot. We will have a very enthusiastic docent to guide us through. If we are lucky, we may even see some recording artists at work. Cost is \$12.00 per person.

Then we're off to a nice 4 year old Holiday Inn Express for check-in. They have offered us a very reasonable nightly rate of \$109.00 with complimentary breakfast and covered parking for our classic Jags. We looked at the rooms and they are very nice with refrigerators and microwave ovens. They have a "meeting" room at our disposal where we can take our cold, frosty, adult beverages and play games and talk. It is a pet friendly hotel and they have a shuttle bus with a 3 mile radius service which should get us to the next day's activities. Rooms will be held until 3 weeks before our arrival. Reservations can be made by calling 918-728-2444 and press 0 when prompted. Ask for the Jaguar Club reservations.

Dinner that night will be in the Daily Grill restaurant inside the Hyatt Regency Hotel. We didn't eat there but they have a semi-private room where we can be seated and it looks very nice.

Saturday we will have a leisurely breakfast at the Holiday Inn before we head out to the Woody Guthrie Museum by 10:00 am via hotel shuttle bus. The bus only holds about 10 people so we will have to go in shifts. We will have a docent led tour. If you want to drive, parking will have to be on the street and is free on the weekends. The Bob Dylan Center is virtually next door to Woody. They have audio headsets for the tour after an intro in the lobby. Combined tickets for Woody and Bob are \$22.00 for the whole day and you can come and go at your leisure and you can go back and forth between the two. Lunch will be at your leisure and on your own. There are a myriad number of small restaurants in the area within an easy walk of the museums including Mexican.

After lunch we will shuttle back to the hotel for a free afternoon. The ladies may want to go shopping at Utica Square

Shopping Center and the gents may want to watch OSU football (OU is off that week) or nap. Since the Holiday Inn doesn't have a bar, we may want to stay at a sports bar around the museums before heading back to the hotel.

Dinner Saturday night will be at the Bluestone Steak House and Seafood Restaurant.

Looking forward to visiting the Oklahoma Railway Museum (3400 NE Grand Boulevard) on June 17th! I've supplied a map showing the location of the museum (see below).

In order to get the group rate, all tickets must be purchased in a single transaction. Please plan to arrive prior to 10:45 am (I'll be there at 10:30). At 10:45 I'll purchase tickets for those present. If you arrive after we've purchased tickets you will need to purchase your own full fare ticket (\$12) and will not be entitled to the group rate (\$10). Those present at 10:45 can pay me by cash or check.

We'll board the train at 11:00 for an 11:15 departure. The length of the ride is approximately 45 minutes. After the train ride, for those who are interested, a docent will give us a tour of the shops, construction projects, etc. If you wish to leave after the train ride, or skip the tour and look around on your own, you are, of course, free to do so. Those on the tour should be prepared to pay a \$1 gratuity to the docent after the tour.

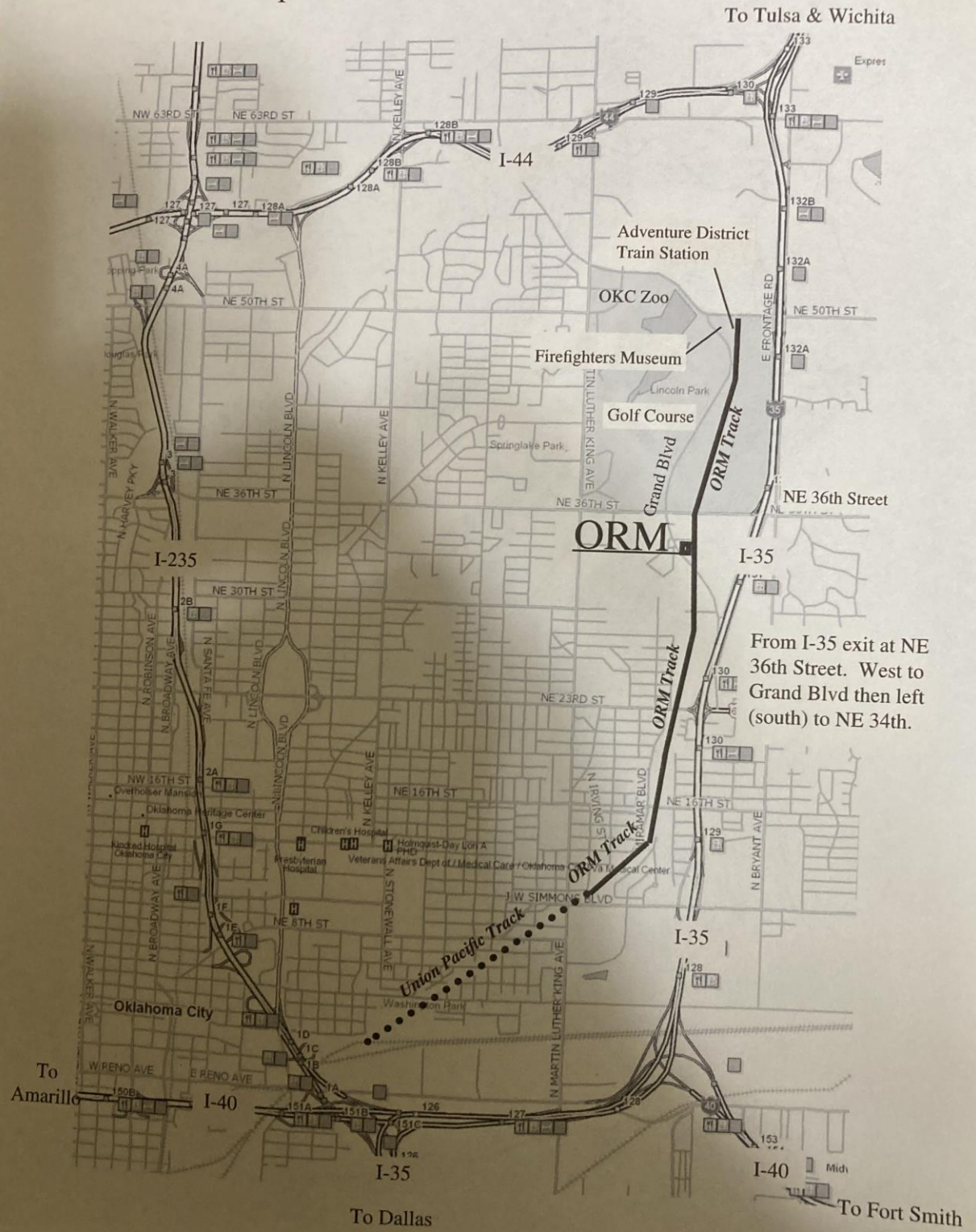

GOVERNING RULES

We will adhere to and strictly enforce the JCNA 2023 Concours D'Elegance Rules while judging all JCNA classes and divisions:

- The decisions of the judges are final. Complaints or disputes will be referred to the Chief Judge who will examine the alleged grievance.
- No Entrant shall judge his/her own car, nor that of a relative, nor that of anyone whose car they helped prepare.
- Visiting Qualified Judges will be utilized and volunteers are much appreciated.
- Each JCNA Championship and Special Class entry will be judged by three Judges. Each JCNA Driven Class entry will be judged by two Judges.
- In instances where an item is listed on the JCNA score sheet, and that item is not applicable for a particular model, the car will receive no deductions for that item.
- All cars will be parked as directed by a Concours Event Representative.
- The Chief Judge may invite an Entrant to move their car from a lower to a higher competitive category but not vice versa.

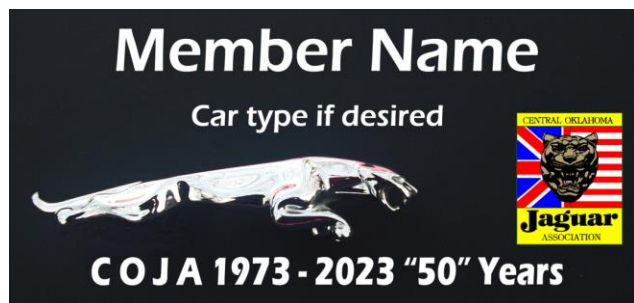
