

- 2. Type in the security-check "captcha" characters that Facebook displays, and then click "Sign Up" again. You can use Windows Live Hotmail, Yahoo!, AOL or another e-mail service if you choose to allow it, or just skip this step by clicking "Skip this step."
- 3. Enter some profile information, such as your high school, college and current employer. You can also click "Skip" to bypass this page.
- 4. Click "Upload a Photo" to put a photo on your Facebook profile page. Browse to locate the photo you want to use, and click "Open" to upload it. You can also skip this step by clicking "Skip." You have successfully joined Facebook for the first time.


