NB-1 a. ARTICLE III. Minimum Number Of Members Required To Start A New Club

Section 2. Requirements: Any group of 20 or more, <u>unless otherwise approved by</u> <u>the JCNA Board of Directors</u>, subject to Article II, may make application for club affiliation in JCNA. The group must submit, together with its affiliation application, a copy of its constitution or Bylaws. Granting of club membership will be contingent upon receipt by JCNA of the designated pro rata JCNA dues for the current year. The group must publish, at regular intervals, a newsletter or other publication which is distributed to members of the group.

Reason: Some clubs are having a difficult time initially finding 20 memberships (a membership is defined as a single person or husband and wife). When an effort to start a fledging club is presented to the board, the board needs the ability to approve it with less than 20 memberships if they think the potential club is viable.
