Pre-arrival Information you need to know

Greetings Jaguar Family from 66 Clubs in the US, Canada, and Mexico:

The Jaguar Club of Central Arizona (JCCA) welcomes you to the Valley of the Sun – Phoenix/Scottsdale. As the host club in 2016 for these 2 very important events, we are writing you today to provide some helpful tips for your visit.

Getting to the Scottsdale Plaza Resort (SPR)

SPR is the host hotel and for those of you driving your cats into the valley please set your navigation systems to 7200 Scottsdale Road, Scottsdale, AZ 85253. There is ample parking at SPR. Please respect the no parking areas which will be used for staging cars for the Sunday concours. For those of you with a concours entry, we have arranged for underground parking starting Saturday afternoon at 4PM. Once you park in the underground parking garage we ask that you do not move your car again until concours set-up on Sunday morning. Additional concours information will be provided during registration.

If you will be trailering your car to the IJF please let us know the size of your trailer. If you provide this information in advance of your arrival, we will

make every effort to accommodate you. Send your request to robertbronstein@aol.com.

Airport Transportation for those of you winging it and arriving at Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport:

Hotel Shuttle -Transportation from the airport can be arranged with the hotel transportation desk (480-948-5000). You will need a reservation and the cost is \$23 pp one way. The schedule will be provided by the SPR transportation desk when you reserve.

Limousine Service - For those of you who want limo service our event transportation company is Total Logistics by Crosby, LLC. You can reach TLC at (480-661-4000) or by emailing to <u>doncrosby@cox.net</u>. Please make your reservation in advance of your arrival to insure availability.

UBER – If you have to ask you do not have it on your phone. Nuff said.

Hotel, AGM and IJF check-in:

Scottsdale Plaza Resort (480-948-5000) check-in is at 3 PM. The hotel is SOLD OUT for Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights so if you will be arriving on these days, it is unlikely an early check-in will be available.

AGM/IJF check-in – Follow the signs, or hotel monitors to the AGM/IJF check-in desk which is located on the south side of the hotel lobby. When you enter The AGM/IJF Grand Entry hall you will be greeted by a member of JCCA and asked to identify yourself and confirm your paid event choices. If you have not pre-reserved event participation, we are sorry but we may not be able to accommodate last minute requests for events which are full.

AGM check-in will be available Thursday 3/31, Friday 4/1 and Saturday 4/2

IJF check-in will be available on Saturday afternoon 4/2 and Sunday morning 4/3

Once you are checked in, you will receive your commemorative credentials which we ask you to wear for <u>all</u> AGM and IJF events. You will also receive a swag bag full of items provided by our sponsors and a day-by-day itinerary of events.

Event Boutique – We have an assortment of International Jaguar Festival event merchandise which can be purchased at the JCCA Boutique. We have a variety of shirts, hats, limited edition posters (especially for this event) and a commemorative program available. Supplies are limited so don't wait until the last minute to shop!

Tidy Cats – At the end of this communication is a list of car washes in the area. For those of you wanting spa services for your cats (detailing) a list of providers in close proximity to SPR is also provided. Please note JCCA takes no responsibility for the workmanship of any car wash or detailer identified. We are providing this information as a courtesy.

What to wear – There is no dress code for the AGM or IJF. That said we do have some suggestions:

During your stay expect plenty of sunshine and temperatures in the low to mid 80's. In Arizona this is similar to the mid-70's in other locations that do not have our dry heat (really!). We want everyone to be comfortable and dress will be "smart" casual, often called country club casual as well. If you are attending banquets: gents please consider jackets; ladies, dresses or dressier pants and tops would be apropos.

Temps drop quickly in the desert at night so please bring a light jacket, sweater or shawl for ladies.

If you will be participating in our Western events on Friday and/or Monday nights, please feel free to come in your finest western duds (jeans, boots, hats, etc.). Yea-Ha!

Photos – There will be many photo opportunities, so bring your cameras. In addition, we have a spectacular location on the SPR property to get that "oncein-a-lifetime" photo of your Jaguar. Our club photographer, Linda Kewell, will be taking concours entry photos on Saturday from 3:30-5:30 on a first- come first-served basis. There will also be random photos taken throughout the event.
