Time to increase our membership dues

As I'm sure you all have noticed, everything in the Bay Area has gotten much more expensive over the last decade. Everything, that is, except the cost of membership in JAG. We have maintained the cost of dues at \$45 (JCNA dues of \$30 have also remained constant) since 2010. Our expenses have, however, increased substantially during this timeframe.

Rather than raise the dues, we chose to utilize some of our reserves to offset the increase in costs to publish and distribute the JAGazette, roster, bank and credit card fees, social media and to subsidize the cost for several of our annual events. After ten years of chipping away at our reserves they have now dropped to a level that requires us to increase the cost of the dues in order to balance our budget. JCNA has experienced a similar issue and will likely be increasing their dues starting in the 2021 calendar year.

As we would prefer to increase dues only once in a great while rather than annually, the board has reluctantly decided to raise our club's dues to \$75 per year for renewing memberships and \$100 for new memberships. This increase would be effective with the 2021 calendar year. This modest increase will allow us to modernize the JAGazette while continuing to provide all the membership benefits you have come to appreciate. As our Bylaws require the membership to approve this increase, a ballot will be printed in the September JAGazette. Please fill out your ballot and send it to me before September 15. I will report the results in the October newsletter.
