



Buick and Jaguar Win Overall Brand Honors in 5th Annual 2021 ALG Pre-Owned Value Awards



ALG recognizes pre-owned vehicles expected to retain the highest value

SANTA MONICA, Calif., Nov. 16, 2020 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- ALG, Inc. the industry benchmark for forecasting future vehicle values, and the analytics subsidiary of TrueCar, Inc. (NASDAQ: TRUE) today announced the winners of the 2021 Pre-Owned Value Awards (POVA), ranking Buick and Jaguar as the top Mainstream Brand and Premium Brand respectively.

The 2021 POVAs are awarded to vehicles with the lowest forecast depreciation from two years of age to five years of age, during the period 2020-2023. Vehicle segmentation is based on ALG's proprietary automotive segmentation, which takes into account information such as vehicle size, transaction price, and cross-shop information.

"About half of consumers trade-in their existing vehicle when they're buying their next car and use that trade-in value toward the purchase of their next car. As consumers begin their vehicle selection process, ALG's Pre-Owned Value Awards are a great resource in helping consumers identify the used vehicles that best hold their value and get the most bang for the buck upon resale," add Lyman.

This is Buick's first time winning in POVA's overall Mainstream Brand category and Jaguar's first time winning in the Premium Brand category.

Jaguar unveils new Formula E car for 2020/21 season



After the Marrakesh E-Prix, the team sat third in the constructors' standings on course for its best-ever finish in FE - behind only eventual champion DS Techeetah and BMW Andretti.

But when the season resumed following the initial COVID outbreak, a dip in form at Berlin - attributed to a loss of car balance - meant Jaguar fell to an eventual seventh.

It has now launched its I-Type 5, which features a new powertrain developed in-house and revised suspension, and that has been homologated for the next two seasons.

Jaguar Racing team director James Barclay told Motorsport.com: "There's over 1000 new components. There's some really cool technology in the car - we actually use 24-karat gold in the invertors.

"We looked at all the areas not only to improve efficiency, but to reduce weight and lower the centre of gravity.

"We've not only looked at the marginal gains, every area we can find an opportunity, but also, where possible, if there are any bigger steps to achieve, we're looking to try and find those as well."

The global health crisis has pushed back some teams' development path, meaning they will delay the entry of an all-new car until April under revised regulations aimed at cutting costs.

Barclay added that Jaguar had always planned to start the new season with a fresh package.

"The championship is getting more competitive every season," he told Motorsport.com.

"We do feel that, although we had a competitive car early on last season, no one is going to stand still.

"Our view was to introduce a new car and that's what we've worked towards."

Dominant Mexico City E-Prix winner Mitch Evans and new signing Sam Bird have extensively tested the I-Type 5 at the Abingdon airfield during the off-season.

Bird, who joined from Audi customer team Envision Virgin Racing, reckoned: "It does feel like a bigger team. No disrespect to my previous team, who were very solid.

"The first day walking into Jaguar, the resources that they have on tap are far greater than what I've experienced previously. We do utilise many of those."

"We've got the tools capable of potentially producing some really great results."

Bird, who previously held talks with Jaguar but deferred joining until the seventh season of the all-electric championship, said he had not waited too long to switch.

"The timing is actually perfect. Every single year they've improved and now is the right time to be joining."

Jaguar Land Rover Builds Fake City To Test Driverless Cars

A driverless Jaguar I-Pace will be used to trial the technology.



Land Rover has been researching and developing autonomous driving technology for several years now. Back in 2018, the automaker announced a partnership with Waymo to develop self-driving versions of the Jaguar I-Pace.

But unleashing selfdriving Discovery and Range Rover SUVs with unproven technology onto the public road obviously isn't a good idea and could cause a fatal accident. Instead, Land Rover is

collaborating with global software, mobility, and telecoms companies to create a "smart city hub" to test self-driving cars in real-world scenarios on streets with cars, pedestrians, and cyclists. As part of a collaboration with technology companies such as Cisco, Seagate, Renovo, and Red Hat, Jaguar Land Rover will develop a private testing facility called the 'The Future Mobility Campus Ireland'.

JAGUAR LAND ROVER DEVELOPS SMART CITY HUB



Located in Shannon, Ireland, the facility will feature eight miles of road to test driverless cars. This will enable Jaguar Land Rover to gather sensor data, simulate different road environments and traffic scenarios, and test new technologies. A <u>Jaguar I-Pace</u> electric SUV will be used to test the self-driving technology, allowing the automaker to advance its research into autonomous, connected, electrified and shared vehicles.

Jaguar Land Rover's test facility will be equipped with sensors, location systems, a data management and control center, and self-driving prototype vehicles. It will also feature smart junctions, connected roads, autonomous parking, and EV charging facilities.

<u>Jaguar XJ220 Featured On Top</u> Gear Destroyed In Horrific Crash

It's the same car Freddie Flintoff pushed to 200 mph in a recent episode of Top Gear.



During a recent episode of Top Gear, Chris Harris, Paddy McGuinness, and Freddie Flintoff drove a Ferrari F40. Lamborghini Diablo, and Jaguar XJ220, three of the most iconic supercars from the 1990s. But as McGuinness found out the hard way, these analog supercars are unforgiving as the slightest misjudgment can end in disaster. The host lost control of the Diablo on a damp road and crashed into a fence, causing extensive damage to the supercar.

Sadly, the Jaguar XJ200 featured in the film has now also been wrecked. Details about the accident are scarce, but it looks like the driver lost control on a country road and slammed into some trees, destroying the front fascia.

The front bumper and right front fender has also been ripped off, the windshield is smashed, and the driver's side wheel has detached. Luckily, nobody was injured in the crash, but the damage isn't going to be cheap or easy to repair. We're hoping this



iconic supercar can be salvaged since only 281 were originally produced between 1992 and 1994. Only 28 are left in the UK, but that number could go down to 27 if this XJ220 is totaled.



It's believed the car is owned by XJ220 specialist Don Law Racing, which provided the car for filming. Don Law Racing also fitted an XJ220 engine into a Ford Transit to transform it into a 200-mph van.

Unlike the Jaquar F-Type the XJ220 doesn't have any modern driving assists like traction control and ABS, so it needs to be handled with care. We

don't know how fast they were driving, but a witness on social media claims "the driver was luckily fine and talking but nearly killed all of us!"

At least the XJ200 was given a good send off before it was wrecked. During its appearance on Top Gear, Freddie Flintoff managed to push the supercar to 200 mph. Under the hood, the Jaguar XJ220 is powered by a twin-turbo V6 producing 542 horsepower and 475 lb-ft of torque enabling it to hit 0-62 mph in 3.6 seconds and achieve a top speed of 212 mph. This performance made the XJ220 the <u>fastest production car in the world</u> until the McLaren F1 arrived.



Experts: Classic Car Owners Should Beware Second Lockdown






IEJC Makes Annual Trek to Palm Springs for McCormick Auctions 2020


