AGM

On January 11th, JCNA convened a Board of Directors video conference to discuss the 2021 AGM. After reviewing the current status and reasonable pandemic forecasts we determined that attempting to hold the AGM in March 2021 would be unlikely to convene a quorum and we could not conduct a meeting. The March 2021 AGM is therefore deferred until travel risks are significantly reduced. Our contingency is to hold the AGM in Columbia in the 3rd quarter or hold the AGM in late October. We will determine our course of action at our June Board of Directors meeting and update all Club Presidents at the time.
