# EDGING IT

President's Article by Brian Blackwell—May-June 2021

May brings a return to in person meetings for the first time in 14 months!! ZOOM meetings were getting tedious, with myself and others having technical problems with our internet service at an inopportune moment. For now, we are going to continue to have our meetings at The Barn Door Restaurant, and 19 of us showed up at the May meeting. As they give us meeting rooms with TV's in them, we are going to return to having presentations monthly about various Jaguar or SAJC related subjects. This month, everyone just wanted to catch up and visit. Next month, the slideshow will be about the 2007 trip several of us made to Indianapolis for the equivalent to what is now known as the International Jaguar Festival, then known as the JCNA Challenge Championship. Photos of the Indianapolis Motor Speedway Museum, and the other JCNA related events, will make up most of it. Since we were going to do that event here in 2009, we went to see how they did it, and that certainly helped. Vaccines work, and I encourage everyone to get vaccinated, especially if they come to our meetings.

Our 32<sup>nd</sup> Rallye to Luckenbach will be held on May 15<sup>th</sup>, with \$20/car registration beginning at 11AM at Rudy's Country Store and BBQ in Leon Springs on IH10 West. First car of a 100 mile, 3 hour Time Speed Distance JCNA Class T2 rally ending in Luckenbach, will begin at 12:31PM. Check [sajaguarclub.org](http://sajaguarclub.org) the morning of the event if there is any threat of inclement weather, as we can postpone to May 22<sup>nd</sup> in that event.

The Annual General Meeting of the Jaguar Clubs of North America was scheduled for late March, but was in doubt still in February. It is now being held the last weekend of August in Columbia, SC, which is the location of the Coventry Foundation archives and nascent museum. Having seen Jaguar Journal articles and Coventry Foundation Facebook posts about donations to the museum of cars and much more, there might be a lot available to see. Just what the Coventry Foundation is, and why it is separate from Jaguar Clubs of North America has been discussed in Jaguar Journal back when the Coventry Foundation was created, but it bears repeating as it can be confusing. In short, tax laws for non-profit organizations drove JCNA to tell members that wanted to create a museum to establish The Coventry Foundation. Legally, they have to be two separate organizations, if donors to a museum want to be able to take a tax deduction for their donation. There are other aspects, but this is the principal driver.

Catching up on magazines which came in during some home improvement projects has informed me of even more global auto industry regulatory changes, coming in the cause of reduced carbon emissions. The impact to Jaguar Land Rover by proposed changes to emissions laws in the European Union would be beyond substantial. No doubt, they are at the root of the JLR decision to be all electric by the 2025 Model Year. By setting a tax on the manufacturer based on average CO2 emissions per mile of all vehicles sold in the EU, electric cars are the only way to avoid being priced out of the market. The bar napkin tabulation based on 2019 sales volume in the EU and the average CO2 emission versus the allowable limit, results in what could have been a 600M Euro total fine for just that model year, about 1600 Euros per car. Now, they sell 5 Land Rovers for every Jaguar, but they are sharing drivetrains, so corporate decision making will be driven by the whole pie. They can't afford to lose that share of the EU market due to regulatory costs, without it impacting cost of sales globally.
