A big Club thanks to both Mark and Chris. As you can see from the photos elsewhere in the newsletter, the event was a big success.

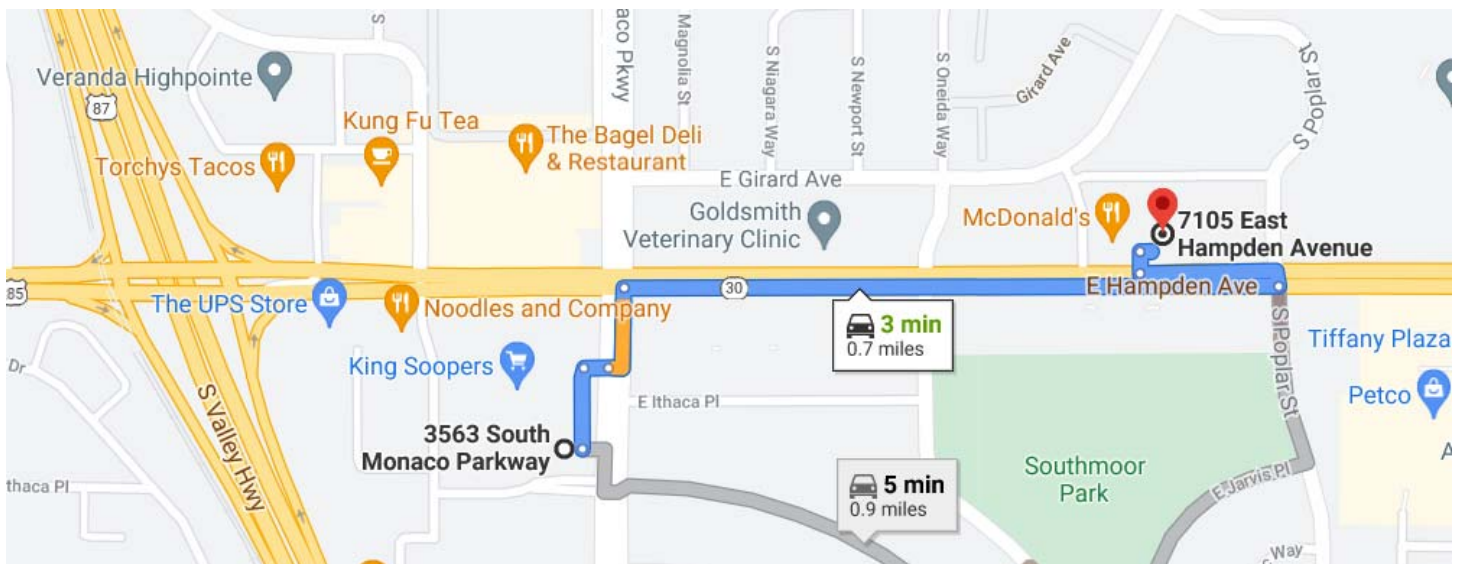
