Mozart Museum and Lunch at AutoVino Mozart Foundation Automotive Museum, Mountain View, CA and AutoVino, San Carlos, CA – June 11, 2022

Every so often, automobile enthusiasts should get outside the familiarity zone of their own chosen marque and look at the grand sweep of automotive evolution. JAG and Rolls Royce Club members have an opportunity on Saturday, June 11th when we visit the marvelous collection at the Mozart Foundation in Mountain View to see 60 of the 120+ cars of this eclectic collection of significant automobiles.

Mr. Mozart's automotive passion comes from his roots, since he was raised among automobiles in his father's dealership in Palo Alto, one of the first in the country to handle Volkswagens, Porsches and Mercedes-Benz in the early days.

When it came time to find his own way in business, Mozart established British-American Motorcar Parts, which he expanded to include Japanese and European parts before selling to a major national auto parts chain.

The museum realizes Mr. Mozart's personal dream of combining his interests in history, automotive development, and motorsports. Completed in 2011, the museum has translucent glass walls surrounding black granite floors, with the cars highlighted by grid ceiling lights.

We have pre-arranged a private viewing for JAG and Rolls Royce members and their guests from 10:00AM to noon. We will be greeted by docents who will show us through the collection and discuss the history of some of the specific cars. After the docent tours we can focus on the cars that have interested us while the docents are available for any questions.

PHOTOGRAPHY INSIDE THE COLLECTION IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

Mr. Mozart is known for moving specific cars from his broader collection as tangible signs of welcome to individual car clubs so we may have some surprises waiting for us.

When our visit to the Museum is complete, we will drive 13 miles to San Carlos and visit Autovino for a

lunch of hand-crafted pizza, sandwiches and salad. After lunch, we can browse the 50 or so autos stored there by their owners and for a fee, we can sample the wines of Woodside Vineyards.

Our entrance to the Mozart Museum is limited to 70 members and guests so make your reservations early. Route Directions will be sent to registrants ahead of the event.



2022 JCNA AGM

Background

The AGM was held in Milwaukee and was organized at short notice as the planned location of Long Island backed out at the August 2021 AGM. The attendance was lower than usual probably due to the closeness to the 2021 AGM, the less than convenient location, and residual concerns about Covid. No Canadian Clubs crossed the border.

The hotel was not to the usual standard. The kitchens and bar were closed and rooms were not serviced each day. The staff was, however, very helpful and meeting meals were acceptable.

The awards ceremony was held at a Country Inn and a good standard.

The event was well organized although the travel between the hotel and the museum visits compressed the meeting time.

Board Meeting

The Board meeting covered the usual business matters. The more noteworthy items were:

- A review of the report from the newly formed Marketing Committee was reviewed and discussed. The Board approved further development of the JCNA Marketing Plan.
- 2. The Board reviewed and discussed a proposal to add a 15 month dues option for new members joining in the fourth quarter of the year to the 12 month dues.
- 3. A great deal of time was spent discussing the fees paid to Coventry Foundation for JCNA Support.
- 4. The Treasurer Report and Financial Plan were reviewed and discussed. The dues increase and an increase in membership have helped address the reduction in reserves. However, the increased fees to CF and inflation will require a revised plan and possibly a future dues adjustment.

5. The JCNA Insurance policies are due for renewal at the end of April and quotes have been requested from 5 different companies and information gathered from other car clubs.

AGM

- 1. The AGM session covered most of the items covered in the Board Meeting.
- 2. The 2022 IJF in Dallas was covered and invites were distributed.
- 3. The 2023 AGM in San Francisco was presented by Phil and was well received.
- 4. The 2023 IJF will be held in Santa Barbara again.
- 5. The Concours Rules Committee proposed rule changes were rejected again.
- 6. Paul Petach gave a brief talk on the NW Region Presidents' calls.
