President's Notes:



Did you know....

September 1935: the name Jaguar, pronounced 'jag-u-er', was selected from a list of bird and animal names for a new model to be powered by a OHV engine. The car company at this time is called S.S. Cars Ltd.

1936: the Desmo Accessory firm designs a Jaguar

mascot which is later referred to as "A cat shot off a fence".

1938: The Jaguar mascot is designed by artist Frederick Gordon Crosby.

This design is different from the Cat shot off a fence and is the design (Leeper) we see today.

1940: the last S.S. Jaguar car produced by S.S. Cars Ltd. is delivered.

1940-1945: As the S.S. Car Ltd. became more involved with the war effort and the factory started producing aircraft parts, motorcycle side-cars and other items needed for the war effort.

1945: The company name was changed from S.S. Cars Ltd. to Jaguar Cars Ltd. due to the bad connotations associated with the letters S.S. of the Nazi regime.

I want to give thanks to Steve Kennedy for this information which was obtained from his book "Jaguar" The Classic Marque. If you have not seen or obtained this book it is an incredible history of the company along with pictures and every
