Vintage Racing at GingerMan Raceway-May 4th

The Vintage Sports Car Driver Association (VSCDA) is holding its Spring Brake vintage racing weekend at GingerMan Raceway, near South Haven, the week-

end of May 4-5.

GingerMan is a two mile long road course. The Spring Brake weekend features multiple classes of vintage race cars, each running in a

qualifying race, then a 20 minute Sprint race.

We will spend Saturday, May 4th at the track, like last year. Practice sessions start at 8:30 am and racing finishes around 5 pm (racing continues on Sunday as well, in case you

want to stay to see more). There is a break mid-day for what they call "Touring" laps. That's when we can,

for a mere \$35, drive our own cars on the track. The track time for touring is around 50 minutes, which

makes this quite a bargain.

Lap the Lake Rally 2024 — Sold Out For Now, But...

Rambler Rallies has really found a niche market running enjoyable picturesque rallies around the country. The one in our neighborhood is Lap the Lake. This year the rally takes place **May 20 to 24**. About 100 cars meet on the North Side of Chicago, and the rally will run through Wisconsin, then Michigan UP, then Traverse City and then down the East side of Lake Michigan.

Every day you are given turn by turn directions if you care to follow them. The large group breaks up into smaller groups that usually go wherever they want and still make the new hotel that evening. Sometimes there are real activities planned, other times not. You will be driving about 220 to 250 miles per day. I went

on this Rally last year with 5 other JAGM cars and we all had a great time. Some are returning to do it again. The routes and hotels change every year.

They give you a list of suggested hotels so everyone is staying together for socializing and planning the next day's adventure. All cars have a large cling sticker on both doors so you can recognize other rallyers.

Go to the JAGM website under Past Events and look up Lap The Lake from May 2023. You will find a lot more information there from the eyes of your Club Members.

Lap the Lake is currently sold out this year, already having 100 cars signed up.

However... last year, there were supposed to be 85 cars and some backed out, leaving 80. Many people reserve early and then life gets in their way, so it's likely you can get a ticket directly from Rambler Rallies well before the trip. The annual **Mad Dogs & Englishmen British Car Faire** at the famed **Gilmore Museum** is the largest all-British car show in Michigan. Plan on entering your Jaguar and spending the day, or the weekend. If 350 British cars and motorcycles isn't enough to keep your interest, there's also the incredible barns full of classic cars on display at the Gilmore.

Jaguar will have a particularly significant presence at this year's show. The "Featured Marque" is the Jaguar E-Type, and the "Rare Gem" is all pre-1961 Jaguars. Expect to see, and be part of, a fantastic selection of Jaguars!

Along with the car show on Sunday, there are a variety of activities available. Here is the lineup—plan to attend some or all.

- Friday afternoon, July 12th—Caravan from metro Detroit area to our host hotel, the Fairfield by Marriott in Kalamazoo.
- Saturday morning, July 13th—The Mad Dogs and Englishmen Car Club offers a Road Rally starting at DeNooyer Jaguar in Kalamazoo and traveling the scenic local country roads in the area, ending with lunch at a local restaurant. The cost of the rally is \$10/car.
