The 2027 Jaguar Type 00 Electric Grand Tourer Is Gearing Up for Nurburgring By: Mircea Panait, Autoevolution

Following a disastrous rebrand, Jaguar unleashed the Type 00 concept concept. Pop-out door handles can also be seen, along with doorin December 2024 to mostly negative reception. Despite being criticized by Jaguar diehards, the most passionate of gearheads, and

the most casual of car enthusiasts, the ailing marque continues testing the Type 00 in preparation for a 2026 reveal.

First spied on public roads in February 2025, the production model is presently gearing up for its first Nurburgring tests. Heavily camouflaged, the all-electric prototype looks very similar to Jaguar's pink and blue showpieces from December 2024. There is no rear window on



Although the concept vehicles have butterfly doors, the real thing is rocking conventional doors. While it's hard to estimate how much legroom and headroom the rear occupants will enjoy in the Type 00, the Rolls-Royce Spectre offers more of both.

> Jaguar won't match the ultra-lux ethos of the BMW-controlled marque, though. Beginning with its targeted starting price of approximately 100,000 pounds sterling, the Type 00 can only dream of matching the desirability of the

either show cars, and the camo wrap on this prototype indicates that Jaguar is sticking to the original design.

The Leaping Cat of Coventry isn't alone in this proverbial madness. Remember the Polestar 4? A coupe-styled electric sport utility vehicle with Geely underpinnings, the poorly named crossover doesn't come with a rear window either. Instead, a roof-mounted camera - which is very noticeable to boot - will have to suffice.

much pricier Rolex. The first zero-emission Roller stars at just around £330,000 in the UK.

Be that as it may, there are some good things about the Type 00. From its 800-volt architecture to a sizable battery and something like 1,000 horsepower on deck, the forthcoming model promises to be that little better than the Rolls-Royce Spectre under the skin.

A near-production Type 00 will be revealed later in 2025 as Jaguar

Inspired by the ultraexpensive grand tourers from the good ol' days of coachbuilding, the 2027 Jaguar Type 00 features a hood that is more akin to a helipad in terms of surface area. Ridiculously long for a vehicle that does not rely on internal combustion for propulsion, the hood in question is complemented by a relatively upright fascia with more air intakes than the concept. Equipped with



massive wheels that are mounted with low-profile rubber, the first Jaguar based on the JEA platform has four doors instead of two for the or 277 miles (446 kilometers), respectively.

comparison, the Rolls-Royce Spectre tops 530 kilometers (329 miles)

continues developing its most ambitious and controversial vehicle vet. Described as a four-door GT, the Type 00 allegedly needs as little as 15 minutes to replenish 200 miles (321 kilometers) of driving range from its purportedly massive battery.

Jaguar estimates up to 770 kilometers (478 miles) in the WLTP cycle, whereas the British automaker's EPA estimate is 430 miles (692 kilometers). By
