## World Events That Happened This Month in 1976



On January 21, 1976 both British Airways and Air France began scheduled supersonic flights of the Concorde. The flights were London to Bahrain and Paris to Rio de Janeiro.

British Airways flights used the callsign Speedbird Concorde. While Air France opted to use the normal callsigns for flights.

Initially the US Congress banned Concorde landing in the US due to citizens protest over sonic booms. The US Secretary of Transportation William Coleman gave permission for Concorde service to Dulles International Airport with both British Airways and Air France beginning thrice weekly service to Dulles on May 24, 1976.

It took until February 1977 for the US to lift the full ban on the Concorde with service to JFK beginning November 22, 1977.

Air France flew its last Concorde flight on May 31, 2003 and British Airways retired their fleet on October 24, 2003.

18 of the 20 total Concorde are survived with 16 of those being on display in North America and Europe.
