2020 Jaguar XJ electric car: what we know so far

Next Jaguar XJ will be an all-electric luxury saloon with a 300-mile range, and it's the first of a series of electric cars coming from the British marque... The Jaguar XJ luxury saloon has a history stretching back 50 years, and



throughout its various generations and guises, one thing has remained constant: it has always been Jaguar's flagship model. Now it's being reinvented as a purely electric car that will take on traditional luxury saloons such as the BMW 7 Series and Mercedes-Benz S-Class as well as electric rivals including the Tesla Model S and the Porsche Taycan. Although speculation around the XJ's future as an electric car stretches back to 2015, Jaguar only confirmed the move earlier this year, on the same day that production of the current XJ ended at its Castle Bromwich factory in the Midlands. Although Jaguar has been coy with any specifics, it says the new XJ "will build on the characteristics synonymous with its predecessors: beautiful design, intelligent performance and revered luxury." The new Jaguar XJ is one of 12 cars nominated for the 2020 What Car? Reader Award.

2020 Jaguar XJ styling

Acting as both a style and technology showcase for Jaguar, the new XJ will retain its sleek profile but have a five-door layout, as opposed to today's four-door car. Such a change is likely to make the XJ more practical, not least because its boot lid will open far wider than it would on a saloon. In terms of looks, the XJ will be the first of a new generation of Jaguars. As such, elements from its design will eventually filter down to other models in the range. At the Frankfurt motor show earlier this year, Jaguar showed off the rear of the car, including its slim LED lights, and the Jaguar name spelt out across its boot lid.

It will sit on new aluminum underpinnings that will eventually underpin multiple models from both Jaguar and Land Rover. Indeed, among the new cars planned to use the platform is a new 'Road Rover' luxury SUV that's scheduled to go on sale towards the end of next year. Inside, Jaguar says it wants to create the most serene and calming car on sale. Indeed, the company's design director Julian Thomson has said that he wants the next XJ to be "as close as you can get to doing Yoga in a car."

2020 Jaguar XJ power and range

The XJ will feature two electric motors – one on each axle, giving them four-wheel drive. And while Jaguar hasn't released any technical details yet, we know the company will be targeting a 0-60mph sprint time of less than five seconds and a real-world range of around 300 miles. For reference, Jaguar's electric SUV, the I-Pace, managed 292 miles on the official WLTP test, although that fell to 253 miles in our Real Range test. The new XJ's arrival should be well timed, with the I-Pace having turned the heads of buyers looking for an electric Jaguar. In particular, the new XJ is tasked with growing Jaguar's market share in China and the US.

Wider electric plans The rebirth of the XJ is part of a wider plan to fully electrify Jaguar's model range. The current XE and XF saloons are expected to be replaced by a new electric SUV when they reach the end of their life cycles in around 2023, while the existing E-Pace and F-Pace SUVs would be replaced by a second-generation I-Pace in around 2025. That would leave Jaguar's upcoming largest SUV, the upcoming J-Pace, as its sole combustion-engined vehicle, surviving until around 2027.

2021 Jaguar XF Sportbrake spy shots

Jaguar is in the process of renewing its entire lineup with redesigns and updates, with the first of the new arrivals already here in the form of the updated 2020 XE.



Our latest spy shots show a prototype for an updated XF, in the Sportbrake wagon body style.



The spy shots suggest we'll see new fascias at both ends, plus a new grille and slimmer headlights. For the taillights, look for the graphic to take on a more angular design similar to what we saw on the 2020 XE.



Expect the interior to be tweaked for a more upmarket feel via the addition of extra soft-touch surfaces and more hand-stitched leather. We should also see a new infotainment system with a 10.2-inch touchscreen display in the center stack. The system should be faster and more intuitive to use than the current laggy version.



The XF is currently available with either a 2.0-liter turbocharged inline-4 or 3.0-liter supercharged V-6. Though it's yet to be confirmed, we should see the aging V-6 replaced by a new 3.0-liter turbocharged inline-6 with this update. The engine is mated with a mild-hybrid setup in other models from Jaguar Land Rover and delivers up to 395 horsepower.

Look for the updated XF to debut in 2020 as a 2021 model. Other key launches at Jaguar this year will be an updated F-Pace and redesigned XJ. In the case of the new Jaguar flagship sedan, there will be a new platform boasting battery-electric power.

Jaguar design boss wants to drive brand toward a more elegant future



One thing we used to do—everyone around the world, that is—was drive.

Julian Thomson, who is now in charge of designing all of Jaguar's cars, remembers fondly that feeling.

"When the world reconnects, I don't want some Uber thing to turn up at my door and take me around for a trip around the countryside. I want to get in and drive. I want to have an experience," he says from his home in England.

The 59-year-old has a stable of cars begging for the open road: two Jaguars, both with supercharged V-8s; a Ferrari Dino; a Renault

Clio 182 Trophy; a Honda Civic Type R; a Lotus Elise; and a modified Subaru Impreza.

"Every car wants to grow up to be a sports car," he says.

Thomson is near the end of his first year as design director for Jaguar, the first year the brand has been without legendary designer Ian Callum. Thomson worked under Callum for nearly 20 years before taking the helm last September, the yin to Callum's yang, according to Julian.

“I had 20 years working closely with Ian. He's a very good friend of mine, remains a good friend of mine. When you work as a little team like that we had a certain, I wouldn't say a tension...but to get that family to challenge each other backward and forwards is really, really tricky.”

Now, the team has a new design studio and new challenges. The upcoming electric XJ sedan is on the way, largely designed during Callum's tenure although Thomson draws from current events to describe its look.

“(The XJ is) all about serenity and calm and good health as well which, against the epidemic we're suffering at the moment, is incredibly relevant for the world going forward,” he says.

Part of that will be to move Jaguar toward a more elegant future, one that capitalizes on the brand's iconic designs—the first XJ among them, Julian says—and pull them forward without running into retro kitsch.

Thomson admits that Jaguar went too far when he first started. The brand's cars overcooked the historic look.

“We overplayed it,” he admits.

“We want a lot more of that romance, that emotional connection, that glamour attached to the brand. We want to bring that back again, not in a retro way, but I think we want to bring the specialness back to the Jaguar brand,” he says.

That won't be in autopods or far-flung concepts. It won't be mobility appliances or brandalism.

“We'll have a level of autonomous cars for people who do want that, there'll be autonomous situations in traffic or highways but this interaction with the car, whatever way you do it, is really, really important. It's what I'm missing so much now. I just want to get out and drive a car,” he says. “(Drivers) want to very much enjoy the trip as much as the destination. I think we're well placed for that.”

Thomson was integral to the redesign for the 2021 F-Type and admits that while the two-door may be the most exciting in the Jaguar portfolio, it may not be the most practical. But it's the one he points to where luxury cars, and Jaguar, may go.

"People dream when they buy our products. They're luxury products. That dream of the open road, and you may only experience it one or two times in the lifetime of the car, but that's what's keeping you attached to that product.

"Everything in the world is telling you (that) you can't drive them, the police are going to stop you, kids don't like driving, they use too much fuel...but still everyone keeps on making them. They represent the realization of freedom and driving and the ultimate utilization of those vehicles," he says.

He practices what he preaches, too.

Thomson says that he should want to drive the car he's designed—he owns at least four cars he's designed and would buy the rest, except that'd be a lot of cars.

"I'm lucky that in my career I have worked on a lot of sports cars and a lot of cars which have become collectible, actually," he says.

He plans on making more, but for now, it sounds like he'd be fine with just one: the one he could drive right now.

JCNA Website Update: I have participated in a couple of JCNA meetings since my last message. I'm pleased to share with you that the upgrade to the JCNA Website is quickly approaching completion with a new look and feel. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING: Although the actual meeting was cancelled due to the Corona Virus, the JCNA quickly recovered with a four hour long teleconference call on March 21st. This

meeting was very informative. However, there was no voting on issues since the rules require annual face to face meetings. We talked about the official AGM, which is rescheduled to **August 21, 2020 in Columbia, South Carolina**.

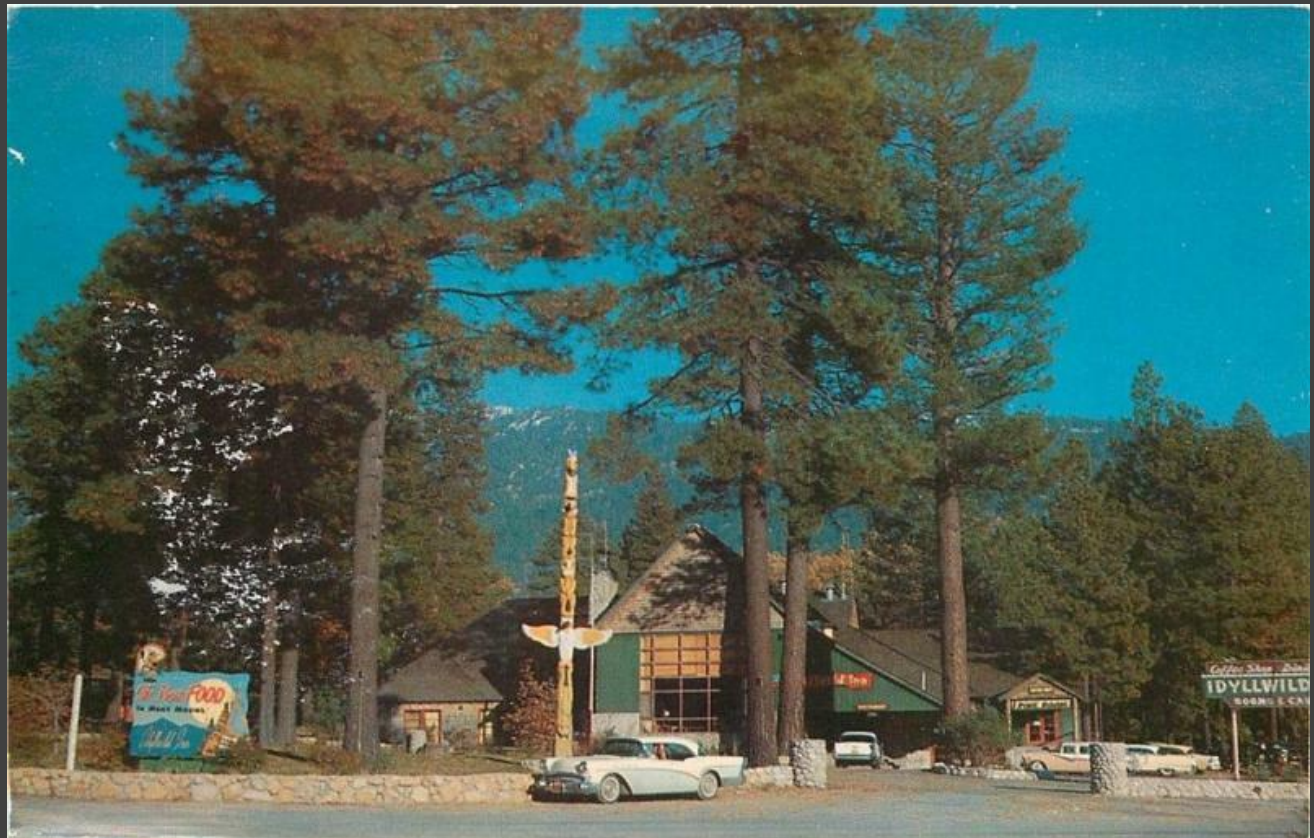

2020 Concours Judges Training.

Preparations have begun for our Saturday July 11th Concours #56 being held at Spanish Landing Park East. Hats Off to Mark Hodges, our President and Concours Chair (among other things) for doing the many tasks it takes to make our event happen! Provided below is a summary of the three types of Concours-related training that I will offer this year. **Please RSVP to me at least 3 days before any class that you plan to attend so that there will be plenty of refreshments and training materials available.**

- Concours 101. A classroom presentation, show and tell, and informal discussion of JCNA concours processes and expectations for those unfamiliar with concours but interested in learning about it. No experience is required; you only need an interest in learning more about JCNA concours. One weekend session is planned on Saturday, May 16th beginning at 1:30 PM in the San Diego Auto Museum training room. The session will last about 90 minutes.
- Concours 201. A session to get Apprentice Judges and Judges whose certification has expired (or is about to) up to speed so that they can participate as Certified Judges at our 2020 Concours. Experience as an Apprentice Judge or former JCNA certified Judge is a "plus", but any member is welcome to participate. Hands on judging of Jaguars using official score sheets, JCNA Concours Rule Books and JCNA Judge's Guides will be emphasized. **One weekend session (27/28 June TBD) for Apprentices and anyone else wishing to brush up a bit on concours judging processes.** A volunteer will be most welcome to host the event. More to follow in these columns.
- Concours 301. The formal, annual Judges' Refresher Training is required each year by JCNA to recertify Judges for the current concours year. It includes a classroom presentation, a review of the more important aspects of the JCNA Concours Rule Book, and discussions of the Rule Book changes for 2020. I plan to highlight the outcome of significant initiatives addressed at the 21 March 2020 AGM and their potential impact on our activities. The written 2020 Judges' Test will be administered. Everyone is welcome to attend. This is an excellent way for Judges and Entrants to learn more about JCNA Concours Rules. Two weekend sessions are planned: Session 1 on Saturday, May 16th at the San Diego Auto Museum beginning at 9 AM, and session 2 on Saturday, June 20th beginning at 9 AM at Classic Showcase in Oceanside. Each session normally lasts about 3 hours.

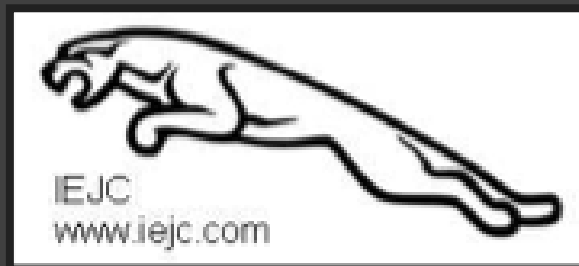
