About Slalom: The JCNA Slalom is sanctioned by Jaguar Clubs of North America. It uses a highly standardized course and electronic timing equipment. It is somewhat similar to Autocross racing., although the course is smaller and much easier to for first-timers to navigate. Cars must pass a simple technical inspection and helmets must be worn (some loaners available). A passenger may be carried. Each entrant is allowed five runs. A "run" consists of three times around the course, using a slightly different route each time. More info about slalom and the course layout can be found at www.jcna.com (click on Events, Slalom).

The times for all Jag Club members will be forwarded to JCNA according to defined slalom classes. No local awards will be given Non-Jaguars will be assigned to class Z but will not be eligible for national JCNA awards.

With 30 cars, we expect racing to finish around 2 PM. A nice, shady area is available where you may set up your lawn chairs. We will also have a small portable gas grill if you would like to cook a burger or hot dog (bring your own food and beverages—no alcohol, of course). The technical inspection is fairly straightforward. Typical reasons for tech failure include no battery holddown, loose spokes, mushy brakes, sloppy steering and excessive fluid leaks.

Participants must show a current driver's license and proof of liability insurance.

Paperwork (registration and liability waiver) will be completed at the site.
